

2010 OFFICIAL KANSAS CITY IRISH FEST KNITTING CONTEST RULES AND ENTRY FORM

1. The contest is free to enter and open to all ages. There is no restrictions on when the piece was created. Only hand-made pieces will be accepted. Limit two entries per person, per day. Winning entries from previous Kansas City Irish Fest Knitting Contests are not eligible.
2. All entries should be considered "ARAN ISLE SWEATERS". On Saturday we will accept adult sweaters for judging, and on Sunday, children's or pet's sweaters. Entries will be judged on appearance, quality and craftsmanship.
3. Entries need to be brought for judging to the contest tent on Saturday or Sunday by 1:45 p.m., along with a completed entry form (below) for each entry. We promise to be extra careful with your entry, but the Kansas City Irish Fest is not responsible for damage.
4. First, second and third place winners will be awarded by 3 p.m. both Saturday and Sunday. The Grand Prize winner will be chosen from the daily winners by 3:30 p.m. Sunday. Winners will be announced first, notified by phone if not present, and later by mail if necessary. Entries may be picked up at contest tent after the judging each day. Any remaining items become the property of the Kansas City Irish Fest.
5. Decisions of the judges are final.
6. Kansas City Irish Fest reserves the right to use winners' names and pictures of their entries for use in future promotional materials.

**We also still accept all quantities of donated 7x9" knitted (or crocheted) rectangles, any pattern, any yarn. These rectangles will be joined together to form quilts, then given to a local charity.*
