


# 2010 OFFICIAL KANSAS CITY IRISH FEST COW ART CONTEST RULES AND ENTRY FORM

1. Keeping with the theme "Celtic Pride in Cowtown," all entries should include a cow with a shamrock on its side. All entries should be considered family-friendly. All two-dimensional and three-dimensional media will be accepted.
2. The contest is free to enter and open to all ages, but only non-professional artists please. Limit two entries per person. Entries must be 11x14" or smaller if two-dimensional art, and smaller than 12x12x12" if three-dimensional art.
3. Entries need to be brought for judging to the contest tent on Friday, September 3, no later than 6 p.m., along with a completed entry form (below). We promise to be extra careful with your entry, but the Kansas City Irish Fest is not responsible for damage. All entries not picked up by 11 p.m. will become the property of the Kansas City Irish Fest.
4. First, second and third place winners will be awarded no later than 6:30 p.m. Friday. You need not be present to win. Winners will be announced in the contest tent first, notified by phone if not present, and later by mail if necessary.
5. Decisions of the judges are final.
6. Kansas City Irish Fest reserves the right to use winners' names and pictures of their entries for use in future promotional materials.


